Don't get caught by these common ICD-10 Myths!

"ICD-10 doesn't affect me because we use DSM-5"

This is one of the most dangerous misconceptions affecting mental & behavioral health care providers. ICD codes are mandated by HIPAA for all medical billing and have been for years. You probably didn't realize that you have been using ICD, because ICD-9 and DSM-IV were overlapping and often identical. However, with the transition to DSM-5 and ICD-10, that is changing significantly, and all providers need to begin planning for ICD-10 now to prevent a revenue backlog this fall.
